London & District Seniors Mixed Singles Tournament Rules and Regulations

- 1. This tournament is sanctioned by the Canadian Tenpin Federation Inc. and all CTF Tournament rules will be strictly enforced.
- 2. **Entries close** ½ hour before the start of shift as lanes are available.
- 3. All and Only Adult members of the London & District Ten Pin Bowling Association aged 50+ as of February 3rd 2018 are eligible to bowl in this tournament.
- 4. The tournament will consist of a singles event. Three consecutive games shall be bowled and total pins plus handicap shall decide the winner.
- 5. Handicap will be 100% of highest average and 220.
- 6. Bowlers must enter on the basis of highest sanctioned league average for the 2016-2017 season for 21 games or more. If current average including all games bowled up to midnight January 21, 2018 is 10 pins or more higher for 21 or more games, then the current average must be used. Please complete the entry form to eliminate disqualification. Bowlers not having a 2016-2017 Yearbook average must use the highest current average for 21 or more games as of midnight January 21, 2018. If no 2016-2017 Yearbook or current average, the 2016/17 sanctioned summer league average for 21 or more games must be used. If a bowler does not have one of the above averages, that bowler will bowl scratch.
- 7. It is the responsibility of each bowler to be sure that all averages are correct. Averages of all winners will be verified those using a lower average than their actual average will be subject to disqualification. All bowlers should be familiar with C.T.F. Rule 319 for average responsibility.
- 8. Tournament winnings for previous 12 months need not be reported but all bowlers are cautioned to be familiar with C.T.F. Rule 319 for possible re-rating. All bowlers regardless of average must comply.
- 9. The average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before participation. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. C.T. F. Rule 319.
- 10. Bowlers may enter more than once, but can **only place once in the prize list**.
- 11. Any player arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame then being bowled. **NO SCORE WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED**.
- 12. When ties for occur the prize money will be combined and equally divided among tied positions.
- 13. Errors in scores must be reported to the Tournament Director immediately.
- 14. No food or beverages are permitted in the playing area, except for medical reasons.
- 15. Incorrect or incomplete entries will be returned to the sender without processing
- 16. Please include full entry fee with entry, **postdated cheque will not be accepted.** Make cheques payable to the London & District Ten Pin Bowling Association.
- 17. Any and all protests MUST be submitted to the Tournament Director in writing within 72 hours of the completion of the tournament. The decision of the Tournament Director and/or the L.D.T.P.B.A. shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
- 18. The Board of Directors of the London & District Ten Pin Bowling Association shall decide any question not covered by these tournament rules. The Board has the power to hear and act on all protests concerning the tournament. Entrants whose names appear heron or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the London & District, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting there from, fires, strikes, lockouts, labour difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the London & District Ten Pin Bowling Association.
- 19. All prize fees will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least 1 in 10.
- 20. Entry Fee per bowler: Prize Fund \$17.50
