On Tuesday, Oct 22, 2024, in the Winnipeg Senior Men's League at Laverendrye Lanes, **Gord Tereck** accomplished a feat that few bowlers achieve in their career. He rolled a 3-game series of 816. His games were 290, 279, and 247. Tereck's first game started with a spare, and then 11 strikes in a row. His second game started with 9 strikes. If you are counting, that's 20 strikes in a row!

This was Tereck's first career 800 series. And what makes this even more incredible is that in this league, we move to a new pair of lanes each game. And there are no practice shots before starting that 2nd or 3rd game. So, it is a matter of making educated adjustments, quickly, to ensure that you don't lose the pocket, or your "carry".

Tereck commented that he barely changed his targets during the series, but people who bowl with him know that he is very adept at making other changes, such as release, speed, and loft when necessary. He also said that this was the most consistent and accurate that he has felt in some time. A high percentage of his strikes were the "ten-in-the-pit" kind of strikes or what we like to call "no-doubters".

His previous high triple was 730 (248-261-221). His career high single is 300 (2).



**Roy Mezzatesta** tossed a 300 in his second game of the night in the Mulder Financial Fun League at Marcin Bowl, finishing the night with 779 (257 – 300 - 222). It was his career 10th 300. The "Mezz" has been close to perfection 14 other times over the years, as he also has 8-299's, 4-298's and 2-297's to his credit in the old American Bowling Congress and the Canadian Tenpin Federation in tournament and league competition.

Nothing seems to be grand enough to capture what a terrific guy Dan was. I've had the pleasure of knowing Dan for almost 20 years, when I started bowling in his Four Play league. But

our friendship really started to grow when my son Cameron joined his youth bowling program at Bowlero in 2009.



Dan was the sitting President of the Windsor Essex Chatham-Kent Bowling Association as well as 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President of the Ontario Ten Pin Bowling Association. He was WECKBA Youth Committee Chairperson and Tournament Director for 4 years and part of the OTBA Youth Committee for 2 years. He was the founder and Secretary-Treasurer for the Four Play League for 20 years.

*Forever grateful to this man!! Dan is irreplaceable but has brought together our bowling family and will watch over us.*

## Know the Rules

### Youth Eligibility Rules

Is this you?

“I have a son/daughter bowling in a CTF Youth League. What do I have to do, or know, to ensure that his/her eligibility for USBC Youth bowling is not compromised? What about their eligibility for U.S. College Programs? What are the differences between CTF’s and USBC’s youth rules regarding eligibility?”

These and many more such questions can be answered by reviewing the Youth Eligibility Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document that is available on the CTF website. Here is the link:

### Do you know the rules?

A bowler delivers their shot, and feels like they stuck at the line a bit, and didn't go over the foul line. But, while at the line, they tested their slide foot and accidentally set off the foul line detector by going over the line.

**Is this a foul?**

There has always been some controversy about this type of situation, and you might be surprised, but the answer is YES. It is a foul. This is clearly stated in the first paragraph of CTF Rule 5a.

On another note, let's talk about **prebowling**, specifically, individual (not team) prebowling. These examples assume that a league has rules that allow individual prebowling.

- A league bowler prebowls for a particular league night and is unhappy with their scores. So they decide to “scrap” those scores and prebowl for that league night at another time.
- A league bowler prebowls for a particular league night that he will be away. They then discover that they will be missing the following week as well and instead of prebowling again, decide to “declare” the first set of scores to be used for the 2<sup>nd</sup> missed week as well.
- A league bowler prebowls for a particular league night that he will be away. However, it turns out that their plans changed and now they are able to make it to bowling that night. So they discard their prebowled scores and come to bowling.
- A league bowler prebowls but wants to “bank it” for some time in the future, but doesn’t know if or when that might be.

These are all against the CTF prebowling rules. Once you declare that you are prebowling for a particular night, those scores MUST be used for that week. And those scores can ONLY be used for that particular week – there is no provision for “declaring” these scores to be re-used for another session.


