- 1. This tournament is for sanctioned youth bowlers in Ontario Youth programs. All CTF tournament rules and regulations shall govern this CTF sanctioned tournament. All bowlers must have bowled in 2/3rds of the CTF youth league schedule by March 30, 2026, before entering this tournament.
- 2. This tournament will be held in six divisions and will consist of three games bowled on one pair of lanes.

 Division "A" 171 & over
 Division "D" 120 to 134

 Division "B" 151 to 170
 Division "E" 101 to 119

 Division "C" 135 to 150
 Division "F" 100 & under

- 3. Bowlers may enter this tournament only once.
- 4. This tournament is a handicapped event based on 100% of the bowler's highest average and 220. The sanctioned average will be based on last year's HIGHEST (2024/25) Yearbook average in any sanctioned youth or adult league. If the bowler does not have a Yearbook average from last season, the bowlers must use their highest current highest average in a youth league minimum 21 games as of March 30, 2026. If the bowler does not have an eligible previous or eligible current year average, the bowler will be given a 220-scratch average. Please note that CTF Rule 319(a)-2 (10 pin rule) will NOT apply for this tournament The league secretary/coach will be responsible for average verifications and must sign the entry form. The sanctioned league average sheets as of March 30/26 must accompany the entry forms to obtain a confirmation of entry in the tournament.
- 5. <u>ENTRY CLOSING DATE WILL BE MIDNIGHT, April 8, 2026</u>. Entries not mailed through Canada Post can be emailed to our association at <u>ldtenba@gmail.com</u>.
- 6. The entry forms must contain both the names and averages of the bowlers and preference of date. Each bowling center or individual will be notified of acceptance of bowling time for each of their entries.
- 7. **No eating or alcoholic beverages allowed** at any time while participating in the tournament. Bowlers not adhering to this rule will be disqualified. Bowlers must remain in the bowling area and be ready to bowl.
- 8. **Dress code**: youth house bowling shirt, no hats or headgear, no electronic devices i.e., cell phones, iPod, no pants with holes, tears, rips, patches, or obscenities. Skirts or shorts are allowed but no shorter than 5 cm above the knee. All coaches must abide by all tournament rules. All bowlers must supply their own bowling balls and shoes. Cell phones can ONLY be used for scoring apps by the bowler.
- 9. Substitutes are allowed when replacements are necessary. The tournament director should be notified at least one hour before the scheduled bowling times, if possible.
- 10. Coaches will have to register with the Tournament Director. Each house is allowed 1 for every ten bowlers entered in the tournament. No on-lane coaching is allowed. **Parents are not allowed in the bowler's area.**
- 11. Coaches or a house representative must register bowlers 30 minutes prior to bowling time with average proof if necessary.
- 12. Any bowler arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame being bowled. NO SCORE WILL BE GIVEN FOR FRAMES MISSED.
- 13. Protests MUST be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 48 hours of the completion of the tournament. Tournament Director Ryan Crossett ldtenba@gmail.com.
- 14. Award fees will be returned 100% to the participants in the form of scholarships in each division on a 1 in 4 basis.
- 15. There will be a scratch option for boys and girls at an additional charge of \$10 per bowler
- 16. Failure to comply with any of the above rules will result in disqualification.
